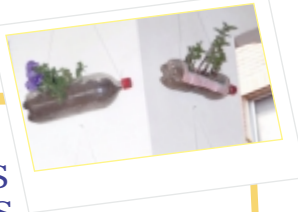
JUNIOR SCHOOL EVENTS

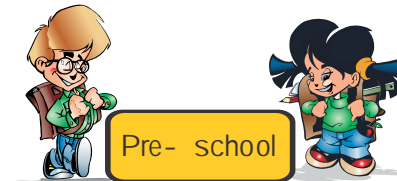


MODEL MAKING
